



USA SWIMMING'S NATIONAL RANKINGS

Both the Short Course and Long Course Individual NATIONAL RANKINGS have come out and ATAC has 5 swimmers ranked in the Top 10 National rankings. These swimmers ranked in the TOP 10 will receive US SWIMMING **ALL-AMERICA** certificates.

LONG COURSE RANKINGS

*CECE WILLIAMS – 16 years old – 200 Meter Freestyle, 2:03.19 – Ranked 9th. Cece was also ranked in the 400 Meter Freestyle and placed 6th nationally.

*The 15-18 Girls 800 Meter Freestyle Relay consisting of DELANEY BARNARD, ALYSSA YAMBOR-MAUL, ALEXANDRIA MERRITT and CECE WILLIAMS placed 10th with a time of 8:28.4

*SCOTT FORTIER - 16 years old - placed 10th nationally in the 200 meter Butterfly with a time of 2:02.42.

SHORT COURSE RANKINGS

*ATAC'S 15 -18 Girls 800 yard Freestyle Relay consisting of DELANEY BARNARD, ALYSSA YAMBOR-MAUL, ALEXANDRIA MERRITT and CECE WILLIAMS placed 10th with a time of 7:25.08.

As coaches this is extremely gratifying to see, since all of these swimmers came through a developmental program as Novice swimmers and have stuck it out through those tough times when things may not have been going as they may have wanted, but obviously they persevered and came out on top in their sport.

SWIM MEET UPDATES:

DAYTONA INVITATIONAL (9/7-9/12) - Daytona Beach.......
ATAC TAKES THE "GOLD" (Again - 6 straight years) Congratulation to all our swimmers that represented ATAC at this meet. It proved to be quite "Fun" for



all our swimmers. Our younger swimmers that don't have the opportunity to swim Prelims and Finals really showed some determination and success by coming back each night in finals and being excited to "swim again". ATAC sent 37 swimmers to the Ryan Lochte Invitational Swim Meet in Daytona (9/7-9/12). There were over 500 swimmers in attendance, but ATAC swimmers successfully defended their title from 2011 with the Daytona Speed Team coming in 2nd.. A highlight for all the swimmers and families was the guest appearance of Olympic Gold Medalist Ryan Lochte presenting a \$25,000 check





from the Gillette company to the Daytona Speed Team for development of a dry land exercise facility. ATAC highlights on their way to this win included accumulating 10 individual High Point awards. These winners were; 8&Under girls -**Evan Jaynes**-1st, Kennedy Brown-3rd; 10&Under Girls -Virginia Russell-1st; 11&12 Girls -Stephanie **Holmes**-2nd; 11&12 Boys - John Yambor-



Maul-1st, Trevor Vandenberg-2nd; 13&14 Girls – Emma Layton-1st, Tara Marie Stevens-3rd; 13&14 Boys – Jackson Brown-1st, Duncan Sutton-2nd.

PANAMA CITY INVITATIONAL (9/21-23/12) - Panama City........2nd win of the Short Course Season.), ATAC once again took the visiting TEAM OVERALL TROPHY. Being able to swim the S.E. Association teams (ATAC is in the Fl. Assoc.) really gives our program an advantage, since we swim some of the best teams in the Florida Assoc. and the S.E. Assoc. by being where we are in the Panhandle. ATAC took 75 swimmers to the Meet and came away with 19 individual high point awards (2 more than last year). There were over 400 swimmers participating from throughout the Southeast.

It was GREAT to see our younger swimmers (8&U and 10&U) come to this meet and contribute to our Team win. We have not had very many newer swimmers making the out-of-town trips lately so we hope this is a new trend. RELAYS in every Age and gender is our goal!

On Friday night, 13 year old and older swimmers competed in the Pentathlon as a prelude to the actual meet and was scored separately. This event consisted of 5, 50 yard races and one 100 yard Individual Medley event. ATAC award winners were Caroline Zapert(13) 5th, Charlie Gallagher(13) 5th, Claire Kercheval-Roig(14) 4th, Olivia Etheridge(14) 5th, Brandon Chason(14) 1st, Lauren Peavy(15) 1st, Ali





Lombardi(15) 2nd, Joey **Briggs**(16) 1st, **Anthony** Stephens(16) 3rd. ATAC scored 1,421 points in the Invitational Meet for all ages outdistancing the Coastal swim team with 814 points and the Dothan dolphins with 532 1/2 points. Individual High point winners in this portion of the meet were; 8&under Girls - Evan **Jaynes**, 4th, 10&under Girls - Virginia Russell, 1st and **Arianna Chambasian**, 5th. In the 11&12 Girls Kennedy **Knisley** placed 3rd and Olivia Kercheval-Roig took home 5th place. In the 11&12 Boys **Trevor Vandenberg** was 1st and John Yambor-Maul was 3rd. In the 13&14 Girls Emma Layton was 2nd and



in the 13&14 Boys **Brandon Chason** was 1st and **Sam Tabacchi** was 4th.

- ➤ BOLLES INVITATIONAL (10/20-21/12) —Bolles School..... There should be some great competition at this meet so those ATAC swimmers going will need their #1 game plan ready.
- ▶ DOTHAN INVITATIONAL (11/3-4/12) Dothan ALA. As many of you know, this is a great meet for many of our swimmers. Dothan is close by and offers our younger and newer swimmers an opportunity to compete with other teams outside of Tallahassee. We always would like to see as many of our Age Group and Novice/League swimmers attend. If you're not going to this one, Dothan has three a year so let's try for the next one. Again, this is a meet we would like to especially see as many Novice and League swimmers attend as possible (see your coach if you have any questions about what to swim). The coaches need to see what you REALLY are doing and swim meets are how we do this. They (meets) are a part of being on a competitive swim





team. ALSO, This Meet will coincide with Dothan's annual <u>Peanut Festival</u> so this will be a fun family weekend. Let's have a good showing at this meet!

> First Time "Winter" swimmers...

We are fortunate to have the support of the City of Tallahassee and want to be thankful for that. However, as the weather changes, there are always issues on a few days with water temperature. If the heater is turned on too early and the weather then turns warm again, the water can become too warm for effective training. So the City staff will wait until the cold weather seems to be permanently settling in before turning on the heater for the Winter. Thus there may be a few days with chilly water in early October. That will pass when the heater is turned on and the water temperature will be held at around 80 - 82 degrees. The real cooling off for the swimmers is mostly due to what





they wear on deck. Realizing they will spend some time on deck, please have an extra shirt, robe etc. in the car they can throw on if necessary. Tallahassee weather can go from hot to cool or cool to hot over the course of the day so be prepared.
